

Reading

Reading will continue to take place daily in Terms 3 and 4. Five sessions a week will be dedicated to fluency and comprehension as well as developing a real love of reading through a variety of activities. We will look at developing our retrieval and inference skills and continue to build up a greater knowledge and understanding of new vocabulary.

Writing

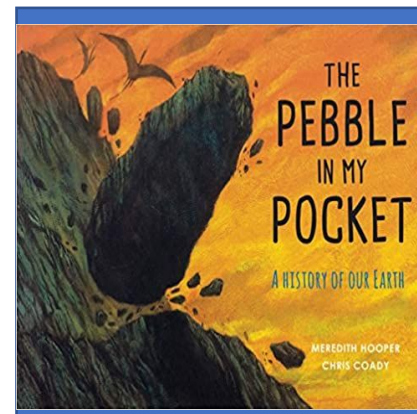
Using our key quality texts, the children will continue to develop their writing skills by writing a narrative, powerful description, recount and an information text. We will be exploring sentence structure, punctuation and sentence openers. We will be using a range of different text features in our writing and learning to edit for improvement.

Mathematics

In Maths, we will be continuing to develop our multiplication and division skills before moving onto money, statistics, units of measure and fractions. We will continue to practice our fluency skills and will spend time reviewing addition and subtraction.

Science

In Science this term, we will be looking at Rocks and Soils. We will be learning about the different types of rocks found and how soil is formed. We will also look at how fossils are formed.



History

We will be looking at and studying the volcanic eruption of Mount Vesuvius and the devastating effects on Pompeii. Our key historical figure for this topic is Giuseppe Fiorelli.

Geography

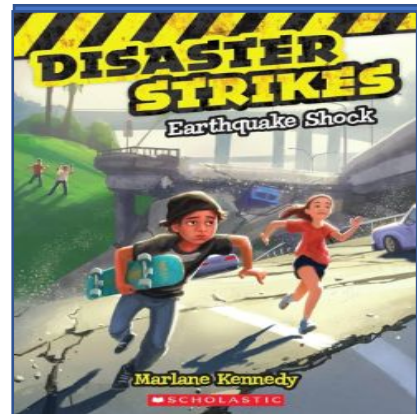
We will be studying the Earth and learning about the causes of Earthquakes, Volcanoes, Tsunamis and other Extreme events caused by Tectonic plates and the forces of the planet.

Art & DT

We will be using a range of skills this term to create art work linked to our topic. Our main focus for these skills will be sketching, designing, sculpting and painting. We will be designing pieces of fabulous artwork which will be created using a range of mediums.

PE

Indoor PE – This term, we will be learning about Dance, including sequences.
Outdoor PE – The Brighton and Hove Coaches will be teaching us precision ball skills and other skills related to a variety of sports.



MFL
